<u>Visit to the Institute of Regeneration and Repair</u> <u>laboratories at Edinburgh University</u>

Last month Professor Tilo Kunath and his colleague Robin Morton gave us a tour of their laboratories at the Royal Infirmary site in Edinburgh.

The visit began with a talk from Tilo about the research into using stem cells to treat Parkinson's that his team are working on. The cells they are producing can be used as a treatment by implanting them in the brain where they develop into dopamine producing nerve cells, replacing the cells lost to the disease. This is currently being tested in an early-stage clinical trial in the Sweden and the UK. These cells are also used to create a model of the disease that is then used to screen new drugs to see if they have potential for further clinical trials.

After this, we were given a tour of the labs and shown some of the cells they are working with.

Our thanks to Tilo and Robin for a fascinating afternoon and all their good work.
