### Walking Club

To help with mobility it has been proposed to start a Parkinson's Walking Club. At present we are suggesting to

start at Gunknowe Lock (Tweedbank Pond). This a short flat area with adequate parking beside, beautiful views, and you can even feed the ducks.

#### CUE 1+ Device

Charco Neurotech is a British company based in London and Cambridge they are now are producing a device called "CUE 1+" which is a noninvasive wearable device for people with Parkinson's. Their vision is to use technology to bring smiles to the faces of people with Parkinson's https://charconeurotech.com/

The CUE device attaches to your body with an adhesive patch. The patch comes with the device and uses a medical grade high adhesive. It is sweat and waterproof, and is unlikely to cause any irritation to the skin.

The patch can be placed anywhere on the body but it is recommended to be placed on the sternum. The patch can be used for about 2 weeks, when it can be easily removed.

It uses PERIPHERAL VIBROTACILE STIMULATION This is using vibration on the skin's surface to interact with the peripheral nervous system and cause a sensory response. The device shows positive results across a range of motor tasks such as, tapping, walking, slowness, stiffness, freezing and generally better improvement. Some people have reported that their tremors feel reduced while using the CUE device.

There are testimonials on the Website, which are interesting viewing. I have been using it for about 2 weeks now and have found an improvement in my walking and I am freezing less. Family and friends have commented on how well I look and how my mobility has improved. It didn't work straight away it took around 3 days before I noticed any difference.

It does come at a cost RRP £795,

If you suffer from Parkinson's you are entitled to have the VAT refunded, Which brings the cost down. You can pay in monthly instalments, which I opted for.
